General Information

The Town of Beaumont Promotions Committee and Event Coordinators are proud to organize this year's FREE **Canada 150th Celebration!** This event will include Bouncy Houses, Laser Tag, Family Entertainment Shows, Main Stage Entertainment, Beer Gardens Food Trucks, Workshops, Family Activities, Glitter Tattoos, Fireworks and so much more! The Canada 150th Celebration takes place over 2 days, Saturday and Sunday, July 1st and 2nd. Beaumont has a population of around 18,000, a vibrant economy, and a wide range of demographics, and in 2016 approximately 5,000 people attended the event over one day. This year stretches over two days, and we expect more than 8000 people to attend this event!

Hours of Operation

Saturday, July 1, 2017: 2:00-11:00 PM and
Sunday, July 2, 2017: (To Be Finalized) 12:00-7:00 PM

Set Up & Take Down

July 1

- **Set-up time:** Food Vendors must be ready for customers no later than 2:00 PM on July 1st, and must be ready for Alberta Health Services Inspection if required.
- **Tear-down time:** Starts July 1st at 10:00 PM. All displays, equipment, etc. must be cleared out prior to 10:00 AM on Sunday, July 2nd. Early tear-downs will not be permitted.
- Help create a festive atmosphere and decorate your Food Vendor in a Canada Day Theme!

July 2*

- **Set-up time (approximate):** Food Vendors must be ready for customers no later than 12:00 PM on July 2nd, and must be ready for Alberta Health Services Inspection if required.
- **Tear-down time (approximate):** Starts July 2nd at 7:00 PM. All displays, equipment, etc. must be cleared out prior to 10:00 PM on Sunday, July 2nd. Early tear-downs will not be permitted.
- Help create a festive atmosphere and decorate your Food Vendor in a Canada Day Theme!

*Event times for July 2nd are to be confirmed. Once exact set up and tear down times are confirmed, Food Vendors will be contacted. Food Vendors are to be open during the entire duration of the event.

NOTE: If you will be providing your food vendor for both July 1st and 2nd your food vendor may stay overnight, at your own risk.

Conditions

Please read this document thoroughly.

Please note that there is a free water station on site for July 1 – 2, so there is no need to provide water for purchase from your Food Vendor. There are no phone lines for debit machines, internet, etc.—however there is cell phone service in the Four Seasons Park. There will be no cash machines in the Four Seasons Park.

Contract

TERMS OF PAYMENT - Absolutely no exception, Food Vendor payment must be received in full on or before the Due Date specified on the invoice provided by the Town of Beaumont after the Contract Registration document has been processed. Food Vendors position will be held until the Invoice Due Date and forfeited if payment hasn't been made.

CANCELLATION - Cancellation of space must be in writing and received by the show organizer by May 1, 2017. In the event such a cancellation is received, full payment will be refunded, less a \$25.00 cancellation fee. If cancellation notice is not received by May 1, 2017, the food vendor shall forfeit 100% of payment.

LIABILITY AND INSURANCE - In consideration of participation in the Canada Day Event, the food vendor shall indemnify and save harmless the Organizing Committee, the Town of Beaumont and all the members thereof, and all other groups working under the direction of the Event, from all fines, suits, proceedings, claims, liabilities or action of any kind or nature (including, but not limited to, cost and reasonable lawyer's fee) arising or growing out of or any way connected to the exhibitor's operation of the Food Vendor and general participation in the Canada Day Event. **Food Vendors must complete and sign the official Food Vendor Registration form and provide proof of coverage of insurance.** To learn more about liability insurance please contact your insurance provider.

CONDITIONS

1. All Food Vendors are required **to have insurance coverage.**
2. The Canada Day event is an outdoor event and will take place **rain or shine.**
3. All Food Vendors must be manned during Canada Day Event (July 1st and/or 2nd) hours.
4. The Food Vendor assumes responsibility for compliance with local and provincial ordinances and regulations covering licenses, permit, fire, safety and health.
5. All Food Vendors must submit a copy of insurance coverage with a minimum \$2,000,000 general liability.
6. All Food Vendors must provide their menu prior to the event for inclusion in the AHS Event Permit.
7. All Food Vendors who will be using a tent must attach a drawing of tent set up, including cooking equipment, exits and fire extinguishers.
