Financial Subsidy Program

The City of Beaumont will subsidize, when possible, Beaumont Recreation and Culture program fees, for individuals and families who demonstrate an inability to pay for programs that would contribute to their personal growth and community involvement.

To qualify for program subsidy, families must meet the criteria by income. The maximum qualifying net household income is \$30,000 for an individual; an additional \$2,000 for a spouse/partner; and an additional \$5,000 for each child.

For example: the maximum net household income for a single parent with two children = \$40,000; the maximum net household income for a couple with one child = \$37,000.

- Financial assistance may be provided for a maximum of \$150.00 per person per calendar year (January 1 – December 31). Applications received after November 30th will receive a maximum of \$75.00 per person.
- Applicant must complete the request for subsidy application form.
- Funds must be used by November 30th. Unused funds will be placed back in the program to assist other applicants who may require access to this benefit.
- Applicant must apply annually for subsidy.
- Funds are on a first come first served basis depending on allocated yearly budget.
- Funds must be used in the calendar year in which they were received.
- The decision of the City of Beaumont is final.

ALL APPLICATIONS WILL BE HELD IN THE STRICTEST CONFIDENCE
