

Regular Council Meeting Notes



April 12, 2022

Open Forum – Snow Clearing Bylaw (8:26)

A local resident requested that council consider a bylaw requiring residents to clear snow from their driveways.

Outdoor Fitness Equipment Donation (15:57)

Administration presented details [regarding a proposed donation](#) of outdoor adult fitness equipment to the City of Beaumont from Michelob Ultra. The equipment has a value of approximately \$70,000 while the City would pay the costs for site preparation. The City would also engage with residents on potential sites for the equipment.

Council approved the item as information. The project was approved later in the meeting as part of the 2022 amended budget.

Outdoor Rink at 56A Street (26:35)

Council [received a report](#) with the results of a public survey asking their opinion on the restoration of an outdoor rink adjacent to 56A Street, along with the estimated cost of restoring the rink.

2022 Budget Amendments (44:12)

Council [approved amendments to the 2022 budget](#) to account for adjusted revenue and additional projects since the budget was passed in December 2021. The tax levy remains unchanged from the approved amount.

Options for Property Disputes (0:26) [Part 2]

Council [approved a motion](#) by Coun. Kathy Barnhart directing administration to prepare a report with options to address conflicts between neighbours related to snow and ice clearing, as well as other property disputes. The report will consider bylaw provisions, conflict resolution options and resources to support residents.

Integration of City Financial Systems (13:06) [Part 2]

Council [approved a motion](#) by Coun. Catherine McCook directing administration to prepare a report setting out a plan to review Beaumont's financial systems, including the possibility of integrated automated systems for customer transactions.
