Open Forum - Pickle Ball (7:38)

A local resident requested that the City install lighting and pickle ball court lines at the tennis courts in Centre-ville and build additional outdoor pickle ball play surfaces.

Arts Centre Steering Committee (17:34)

Representatives from the Arts Centre Steering Committee <u>reported on their progress</u> to review options for a performing arts centre in Beaumont. Council received the report for information.

Audited Consolidated Financial Statements (1:16:32) and (0:07) [Part 2]

Council received the results of the <u>annual audit</u> of the City's financial statements from auditor Grant Thornton. The City ended the 2021 year with an operating surplus of \$183,000.

Lights at Tennis Court and Skate Park (11:12) [Part 2]

In response to a motion from Council, Administration <u>presented a report</u> with options to install lighting at the tennis courts and skate park in Centre-ville. Council received the report for information.

Short Term Rental Properties (24:44) [Part 2]

Council approved a <u>motion by Mayor Bill Daneluik</u> requesting a report from Administration regarding an outline of current rules regulating short term rentals, such as Airbnb, in Beaumont and an analysis of regulations in other communities.

Property Tax and Supplementary Property Tax Bylaw (28:49) [Part 2]

Council <u>passed a bylaw</u> setting the property tax and supplementary property tax rates based on the tax levy approved by Council in the 2022 budget.
