Facilities Joint Use Agreement With Black Gold School Division (5:43)

Council <u>approved an updated agreement</u> that allows Black Gold schools to use City of Beaumont facilities, as well as allowing the use of schools for City programming. The City and school division have had an agreement in place since 1997.

Council also directed City Administration to prepare a report with cost options to host Black Gold high school graduation celebrations at the Beaumont Sport and Recreation Centre.

Don Sparrow Lake Lighting and Ice Fishing (34:27)

Council <u>received a report</u> regarding the timing of lighting and signage for ice fishing at Don Sparrow Lake in Four Seasons Park. The report also looked at options to expand the skating surface and adding more picnic tables at the lake.

Lighting for Outdoor Rinks (49:53)

Council received a report examining options to add portable lighting at neighbourhood outdoor skating surfaces.

Council Input on City Capital Budget (1:15:09)

Council approved a <u>motion by Coun. Sam Munckhof-Swain</u> directing Administration to prepare a report with options to engage City Council on their capital priorities before the draft capital budget is presented to them.

Snow Control Service Levels (1:30:18)

Council approved a <u>motion by Coun. Catherine McCook</u> directing Administration to prepare a report with options and costs to improve snow control service levels, review snow removal practices, and alternative ways to communicate snow removal.

Health Support Advocacy for Beaumont (1:35:29)

Council approved a <u>motion by Mayor Bill Daneluik</u> to advocate to the Alberta government for a second ambulance in Beaumont and a walk-in medical centre.
