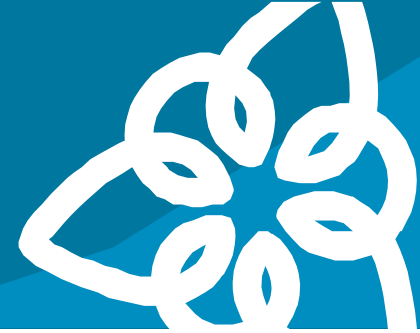


Regular Council Meeting Notes



July 12, 2022

Open Forum – Zero Lot Lines (5:22)

A resident expressed concerns about the City of Beaumont's use of zero lot lines in residential development.

Open Forum – Playground Lighting (14:11)

A resident requested support for lighting at the Académie Saint-André Academy to help deter vandalism.

Library Annual Report (29:36)

Director Laura Winton reported to Council on the [Bibliothèque de Beaumont Library's activities](#) in 2021.

Beaumont Sport and Recreation Centre School Passes (46:16)

Council [approved a pilot project](#) to provide each school in Beaumont with two passes for the Beaumont Sport and Recreation Centre that could be borrowed for a short period by students.

Recreation Fees for Residents Receiving Income Assistance (56:03)

Council [approved a plan](#) to provide residents receiving provincial support from the Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped (AISH) program with free access to the City's facilities beginning January 1, 2023. Council also approved a motion directing Administration to report back on the implications of extending free facility access to residents receiving other provincial income supports.

High School Football Home Game Event (1:11:41)

Council [approved funding to host a event](#) for the community celebrating the Beaumont high school football team's first home game at the new multi-use recreation field in Four Seasons Park.

Resources for Resident Dispute Resolution (0:11) [Part 2]

Council [approved the implementation of resources](#) to support the resolution of disputes between residents. The Strathcona County Community Mediation Society has agreed to extend its services to Beaumont residents and Administration will develop a resource page on the City's website.
