# Open Forum - Snow Clearing Bylaw (6:46)

A local resident detailed concerns about residents shoveling snow on to their neighbours' property without permission. He requested that council consider a bylaw against the practice.

## Thrift Centre and Food Bank Satellite Proposal (10:15)

Members of a local group formed to promote social enterprises <u>presented a proposal</u> for a Community Circle Thrift Centre and a satellite location for the Leduc & District Food Bank in Beaumont. The group requested \$60,000 in 2022; \$40,000 in 2023; and \$20,000 in 2024 from the City to fund the project.

Council directed Administration to prepare a report on the feasibility of accommodating the funding request.

## Fire Response Times (45:45)

Council <u>received a presentation</u> regarding Beaumont Fire Service response times, building code requirements and implications related to response times, and options to reduce the time it takes to respond to calls.

Council directed Administration to prepare a strategy to enhance fire services for consideration in the 2023 budget.

# Streaming Options for Council and Committee Meetings (1:34:48)

Administration presented a <u>report with options</u> to improve the quality of livestream broadcasts of City Council and Committee meetings for the public. Council received the report for information.

### Recreation Fees for Citizens on Income Assistance (1:43:04)

Council <u>approved a motion by Mayor Bill Daneluik</u> directing Administration to prepare a report on the feasibility and considerations for eliminating fees to access the City's recreation facilities for residents on the Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped (AISH) program.
