Triomphe Estates Outline Plan Amendment (6:56)

Council <u>approved an amendment</u> to the Triomphe Estates Outline Plan that provides guidance for land development in the neighbourhood. The amendment eliminated an alley connection and incorporated a walkway to improve pedestrian connections.

Community Grant Program Recipients (16:46)

Council <u>approved four grants</u> totaling \$24,500 to local organizations for events and projects in Beaumont. Community grant applications are reviewed by a volunteer committee and recommended to council for funding approval.

Satellite Food Bank and Thrift Centre (23:07)

Council <u>approved three-year funding</u> for a satellite food bank in Beaumont. The initiative is being organized by local volunteers in partnership with the Leduc & District Food Bank. Funds will be allocated from the fiscal stabilization reserve to provide \$60,000 for the first year, \$40,000 for the second year, and \$20,000 for the third year.

Local Transit Planning (57:05)

Council <u>directed Administration to undertake a study</u> of potential ridership for local transit service within Beaumont. A report and potential funding options for a pilot project will be returned to Council by the end of the year.
