Open Forum - Construction Issues (4:06)

Council heard from a resident of the Forest Heights neighbourhood regarding development construction issues.

Black Gold School Division High School Graduation (25:19)

Council <u>approved a change</u> to the City's facility joint-use agreement with the Black Gold School Division. The revised agreement provides a \$4,500 annual credit to the division for a discounted rate to use the Beaumont Sport and Recreation Centre for high school graduation celebrations.

Implications of Expanded Senior Access Membership at BSRC (31:27)

Administration <u>reported</u> that expanding senior access membership program hours at the Beaumont Sport and Recreation Centre would reduce fee and membership revenue by \$33,000 per year. Council received the report for information.

BSRC School Pass Pilot Project (38:06)

Council <u>approved a motion</u> by Coun. Catherine McCook directing Administration to provide a report on options and implications of a pilot project that would offer Beaumont Sport and Recreation Centre passes to schools.

Adaptive Recreation Programming (43:03)

Council <u>approved a motion</u> by Coun. Catherine McCook directing Administration to provide a report on adaptive recreation programming offered by the City, including opportunities for expanding programming.

Crosswalk Lights (53:20)

Council <u>approved a motion</u> by Mayor Bill Daneluik directing Administration to provide a report on options for installing crossing signals at up to six crosswalks.

Minor Football First Home Game Event (1:01:35)

Council <u>approved a motion</u> by Mayor Bill Daneluik directing Administration to provide a report on options and costs to hold a home game opener event for minor football.

Council <u>delayed reading</u> of its Code of Conduct Bylaw until a meeting when all members can be present.

St. Vital Neighbourhood Water Main Replacement (0:14) [Part 2]

Council <u>approved a budget amendment</u> to replace a section of the potable water main in the St. Vital neighbourhood concurrent with water system renewal construction in the area.

Report Extensions (0:15) [Part 3]

Council approved extensions for reports from Administration regarding a high school site, amendments to the land use bylaw, and how other communities regulate short-term rentals such as Airbnb.
