Community Grant Funding Recipients

Council approved the recommendations of the Grant Funding Advisory Committee to award a total of \$34,140 in grants to community groups. The program offers matching grants to local non-profit and community organizations.

Permanent Rink Shelters and Zamboni Storage Garage

Council voted to reduce the scope of the outdoor rink shelters and Zamboni storage project in the 2023 capital budget. The initially approved project included construction of three shelters and a storage garage. However, the costs were higher than estimated and Council reduced the project to the design of a shelter and garage in 2023 at the J.E. Lapointe outdoor rink and design of a rink shelter at the Dansereau rink.

Traffic Safety Bylaw

Council voted to remove the dangerous goods routes provisions from the Traffic Safety Bylaw and proceed with implementation of the bylaw on June 1. The provisions will be reintroduced at a later time to ensure they are compliant with provincial legislation.

Council also deliberated but chose not to proceed with potential amendments for the provisions regarding RV parking.

LeBlanc Canal Pathway and Footbridge

Council approved a motion by Coun. Steven vanNieuwkerk to have Administration prepare a report on options, timing and costs to install a pathway and bridge connecting the path directly west of 63 Street across the LeBlanc Canal to the Beaumont Sport and Recreation Centre parking lot.
