



Beaumont Design Review Committee FAQs

Q. Do I need to be a resident of Beaumont to apply?

No, professional members and those representing the development industry do not need to live in Beaumont. Applicants will be evaluated based on their:

- Demonstrated level of expertise and knowledge in their field;
- Knowledge of the composition and character of the City and/or the region that enables the member to make a positive contribution towards improving Beaumont's built environment; and
- Ability to work in a multi-disciplinary review team.

Q. What is the time commitment?

The time commitment is a minimum of two (2) meetings per year up to one (1) meeting per month. The meetings are anticipated to be held in the evening but this will be determined at the first committee meeting.

Q. Do I need to hold a designation with my professional association to apply (i.e. RPP, P.Eng etc)?

For applicants other than a member at large or development industry representative, preference will be given to applicants who have 5 years of relevant experience and are full members of their professional association.
