
Regular Council Meeting Notes



August 25, 2020

RCMP Quarterly Report (6:41)

RCMP Staff Sgt. Jeff Egan <u>provided an update</u> on the detachment's activities between April 1 to June 30, including crimes and other offences reported to the RCMP.

Beaumont Night Market (38:53)

Council received a <u>report from Empowering Women Entrepreneurs</u> regarding the Beaumont Night Market, including long-term plans for the event.

Transportation Master Plan (51:17)

Council <u>approved Our Connectivity, Transportation Master Plan</u>. The plan guides development of transportation systems in the community for the effective movement of people, goods and services.

Drainage Assessment (4:59) [PART2]

Council <u>received the results of a review of drainage</u> in the northwest corner of Range Road 243 and Highway 625, following concern about high water levels in the area earlier this year. Council also directed administration to return with potential solutions for council's consideration this fall.

Threat Risk Assessment Protocol (48:25) [PART 2]

Council <u>approved the renewal of Beaumont's participation</u> in the Leduc and Area Violence Threat Risk Assessment Protocol. The protocol brings together school and community-based partners to respond to threats of violence in schools.

Municipal Election Signage, and Signature and Deposit Requirements (0:29) [PART 3]

Council <u>discussed a motion</u> by Mayor John Stewart to consider signage rules for municipal elections, along with the number of signature required for nomination and deposits by candidates. Council agreed to discuss the matter further during a Committee of the Whole meeting in September.

Assessment of Intersection (22:46) [PART3]

Council <u>discussed a motion</u> by Coun. Bill Daneluik directing administration to conduct a traffic assessment of the intersection of Township Road 510 and Range Road 243. Council requested additional information from administration for consideration at the September 8 regular meeting of council.
