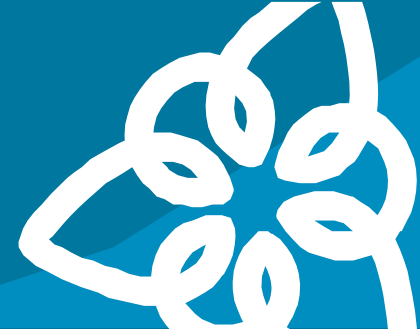


Regular Council Meeting Notes

Presentations from Beaumont Society for the Arts and Beaumont Blues and Roots Festival (6:01)

Chantal Yardley ([Beaumont Society for the Arts](#)) and Jeremy Kornel ([Beaumont Blues and Roots Festival](#)) presented updates about objectives, year-end finances and fundraising. Council received the presentations for information.

Mid-sized Cities Mayors' Caucus Membership Fee and Advocacy Letter (34:58)

City Administration updated Council on:

- the Mid-sized Cities Mayors' Caucus' (MCMC) [membership funding request](#) of \$2,000 to offset costs incurred hosting the group; and
- its recommendation for City Council to [sign an advocacy letter](#) from MCMC regarding the downloading of RCMP retroactive pay onto municipalities.

Council approved both items.

Council approved a [motion](#) by Coun. Steven vanNieuwkerk directing Administration to bring back a report on Beaumont's High Intensity Residential Fire requirements, including options and considerations for improving fire department response times.

Report on Rationale for Light Timing and Ice Fishing Signage at Don Sparrow Lake (52:54)

Council approved a [motion](#) by Coun. Ashley Miller directing Administration to bring back a report on amenities at Don Sparrow Lake, including lighting, signage, skating surface area and picnic tables.

Council approved an amended [motion](#) by Mayor Bill Daneluik directing Administration to bring back a report about improving pedestrian safety at the intersections of 56A Street and 55 Avenue and 56A Street and Montalet Street.
