Recreation, Parks and Culture Advisory Committee (2:32)

Martin Carnegie <u>presented a report</u> to council on the Recreation, Parks and Culture Advisory's Committee's work in 2020. The committee consists of Beaumont residents and was established to advise council on recreation, parks and culture programs and services.

Capital Project Dashboard (18:05)

City administration provided a demonstration of an online dashboard that displays the status of capital and renewal projects. The dashboard will be updated regularly and enable residents to view progress of City of Beaumont projects.

Beaumont Minor Baseball Proposal (42:15)

Warren Chandler and Neil Jorgensen from the Beaumont Minor Baseball Association proposed a partnership with the City of Beaumont to construct a fifth diamond in the west recreation site. The association has applied for a grant from the Toronto Blue Jays to fund the project. Council agree to support the application.

West Recreation Space (1:11:50)

Council <u>received an update</u> on planning for the construction of a baseball diamond complex and dog park on city-owned property in west Beaumont. Council directed administration to present options and costs to increase the size of the dog park.

Face Covering Bylaw (2:04:29)

Council decided to let the city's face covering bylaw lapse on the scheduled expiry date of January 31 given the Alberta government's requirement for people to wear masks in public indoor spaces to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
