Regular Council Meeting Notes



June 22, 2021

Air Services Opportunities Fund (4:44)

Council approved a <u>contribution of \$222,500</u> over three years for a fund to support efforts by the Edmonton International Airport to retain and attract air service routes. Municipalities in the Edmonton region are contributing a total of up to \$15 million for the fund, to be administered by Edmonton Global.

Social Master Plan Progress Review (53:41)

Council received an <u>update on progress</u> on implementation of Beaumont's Social Master Plan. The plan was approved in June 2019, with actions to enhance the well-being of Beaumont residents through "compassion, inclusion and resiliency."

Performing Arts Centre Steering Committee (1:37:57)

Council approved the <u>terms of reference for a steering committee</u> to review work completed to date for a performing arts centre and make recommendations for its size, site, design and operational model. Council also <u>approved the appointment</u> of six members to the steering committee.

The steering committee is expected to provide recommendations to council for the 2023 budget process.

Lakeview Redistricting (2:03:54)

Council approved the first of three readings needed to change the designated use of portions of land within Lakeview.

Kick it to the Curb Program (2:27:25)

Council approved a motion from Coun. Martin Stout to consider implementing a program that would allow residents to swap unwanted items by leaving them on their curbs during a designated day. The program will be considered in the 2022 budget process.
