
# Regular Council Meeting Notes



March 9, 2021

## Open Forum - Beaumont Dog Park (3:28)

Resident Mike LeMoine asked council to consider <u>expanding the size of the dog park</u> currently planned for the west recreation site.

### Job Boards and Tourism Promotion - Leduc & Wetaskiwin Region Chamber of Commerce (15:58)

Jennifer Garries, executive director of the Leduc & Wetaskiwin Region Chamber of Commerce, gave council a presentation regarding a marketing initiative for tourism in the region and a job board for employers and job seekers in the region. The Chamber offered the City of Beaumont the opportunity to participate at a cost of \$15,000 for tourism marketing and \$3,000 for the job board.

Council directed administration with explore the opportunities further with the Chamber.

# **Beaumont Blitz Fastball (36:30)**

Representatives from the Beaumont Blitz Fastball Association <u>provided an overview of their organization</u> and proposed a fund-raising initiative to build electronic scoreboards at the west recreation site.

# National Road Cycling Championship (1:07:02)

Council approved sending a letter in support of <u>Edmonton Triathlon's bid</u> to host the Canadian Road Cycling Championships in 2022-23. If the event is awarded to Edmonton Triathlon, time trials would be hosted in Beaumont.

### **Operating Line of Credit (1:16:28)**

Council approved a bylaw allowing the city to <u>establish a line of credit</u> to be used in the event the city required short-term cash flow for operating requirements. Related to the bylaw, the city is also developing a policy for the investment of funds in city reserves that are not required immediately.
