May 11, 2021

Waste to Energy Presentation (6:06)

Council received <u>a presentation on the feasibility</u> of processing waste at the Leduc and District Waste Management Facility into energy.

Beaumont Welcome Service (23:01)

Council <u>approved a service</u> providing a welcome letter to new residents that directs them to resources in the community, and agreed to consider options for more comprehensive services during deliberations for the city's 2022 budget.

Joint Recreational Space Feasibility Study (40:45)

Council <u>discussed a study</u> exploring the potential for a joint recreation site with Leduc County. The report identifies different recreation options for sites within the county near Beaumont.

Community Grant Funding Recipients (1:13:00)

Council <u>approved grants totaling \$27,874</u> for five local organizations from the city's community grant program. The program supports projects, initiatives, events or start up operating costs for community groups. Grant applications are reviewed by an advisory committee and recipients are recommended to council.

West Recreation Site (1:30:33)

Council <u>approved an increase in funding</u> for the west recreation space at Township Road 505 west of Range Road 243. Initial funding had been approved in fall 2020, with the expectation that full costs would be determined from a request for proposals process.

Council also agreed to defer a project for a town square in Centre-ville and reallocate the funding to the west recreation project.
