Presentation to Council - Face Covering Bylaw (7:24)

Resident Chris Schaefer provided a presentation to council in opposition to the city's temporary face covering bylaw.

Library Budget Request (15:39)

Laura Winton, Director of Bibliothèque de Beaumont Library requested funding for a book bike, library expansion and library expansion design from the city's capital budget. Council referred the matter for consideration as part of the 2021 budget process.

Beaumont Blues and Roots Festival Budget Request (43:29)

Jeremy Kornel from the Beaumont Blues and Roots Festival provided council with an <u>update about the festival's financial</u> <u>position</u> due to the pandemic and asked for funding in 2021. Council referred the matter for consideration as part of the 2021 budget process.

Beaumont Chamber of Commerce Budget Presentation (59:06)

Representatives from the Beaumont Chamber of Commerce provided a presentation to council with a number of recommendations that council consider as part of its budget deliberations.

Chateaux de Beaumont Condominium Corporation Presentation (1:20:00)

Rolf Traxel, representing owners of Chateaux Beaumont condominium association, <u>requested council re-examine</u> the city's tax rate for bareland condos. He explained that residents at Chateaux de Beaumont pay directly for maintenance of the sidewalks, roads, lighting, streetclearing and other services typically provided by the municipality and should pay a lower tax rate than other residents.

Report on TWP Road 510 and Range Road 241 Intersection (1:34:51)


