City of Edmonton and City of Beaumont Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework

Council received a <u>report</u> on the City of Edmonton and City of Beaumont Intermunicipal Collaboration Framework. The Framework commits the partners to share information and connect with one another, while seeking partnership opportunities as they arise. Council approved the Framework planning and delivery of joint recreation services along the shared municipal boundaries in the future.

Election Signage Regulations

Council received a <u>report</u> with recommended changes to regulate election signage by using an appropriate enforcement mechanism and bylaw. The recommendations included amending timelines for when signs must be removed following an election, prohibiting signs in specific locations, require distances from specific locations, separating distancing between signs and the size of signage. Council directed Administration to make the recommended changes (to be adopted by Council prior to January 1, 2021), and voted against mandating 50 election signs per campaign.

Overland Drainage Assessment

Council received a <u>report</u> with an option to address the overland drainage concerns at the northwest corner of Range Road 243 and Highway 25. Council voted to proceed with the recommendation to perform debris removal at a cost of \$15,000. A comprehensive watershed plan/survey request was asked to be brought back at budget time.

Beaumont Sport and Recreation Centre Noise Abatement Update

Council received a <u>report</u> regarding resident noise complaints when the fans are running on the arena refrigeration ice plan condensing tower at the Beaumont Sport and Recreation Centre. Options to address the noise level ranged from \$20,000 to \$125,000. Council directed administration to bring back an estimate on a sound study and all the noise abatement options at budget time.
