Open Forum - Concerns Regarding Temporary Face Covering Bylaw (4:50)

Two residents spoke to council in opposition to the city's Temporary Face Covering Bylaw. The bylaw requires face coverings to be worn in indoor public places and vehicles in order to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Royal Canadian Legion Poppy Campaign (16:51)

The president of the Royal Canadian Legion Leduc Branch presented council with the first poppy of its annual poppy fundraising campaign. Proceeds from the campaign support veterans and their families.

Conversion Therapy Policy and Bylaw (21:36)

Council reviewed a draft policy that would restrict the use of city resources and funding to organizations that conduct or promote conversion therapy, along with a draft bylaw that would prohibit businesses from practicing conversion therapy within Beaumont. Council referred both the policy and bylaw back to city administration to further review the definition of conversion therapy.

Temporary Face Coverings Bylaw Extension (1:06:52)

Council <u>extended the city's Temporary Face Coverings Bylaw</u> from October 31, 2020 to January 31, 2021. The bylaw requires that face coverings be worn in indoor public place and vehicles in order to prevent the spread of COVID-19.
