

# **Regular Council Meeting Notes - October 8, 2019**

## **Beaumont and District Heritage Society (6:30)**

The Beaumont and District Heritage Society updated the council on progress for the relocation and restoration of the St. Jacques Heritage House. With the home on its new foundations and services running to the site, the society is beginning to raise funds to complete the project. Sponsor levels will be available to donors and a heritage DVD will be for sale as part of the fund-raising campaign.

## **Beaumont Bears and Bandits Football (16:58)**

Supporters of the Beaumont Bears and Bandits football teams presented details of a proposal to upgrade the playing field near Beaumont Composite High School. Council heard that the teams have been unable to host a home game in Beaumont in 25 years due to the field conditions. Proponents suggested an upgraded field and facilities, including stands and changing rooms, could also be used by other organizations for competitions and practices.

## **Community Events Committee Bylaw (36:24)**

Council approved a bylaw changing the name of the Promotions Committee to the Community Events Committee, more accurately reflecting the group's current mandate. Council also reduced the committee's size to seven members from 11 to make it easier to fill vacant seats on the group.

The committee's role includes advising the city and actively participating in the coordination and promotion of community events that showcase Beaumont.
