Regular Council Meeting Notes



September 22, 2020

Skate Park Art Proposal (4:30)

Resident Coreina Hubert presented a proposal for a spray paint artist to work with local youth to design murals in the Beaumont skate park. Council referred the suggestion to city administration for consideration in the 2021 budget.

Beaumont Society for the Arts (15:34)

Beaumont Society for the Arts president Chantal Yardley presented a <u>review of the society's activities</u> in 2019. She also proposed the city create a position for an arts and culture manager in city administration.

Tax Recovery Process (37:58)

Council <u>approved the sale of 22 properties</u> to recover city taxes owed on the land and set reserve bids at the assessed market values of the properties. The properties will be sold at public auction on December 11, unless the taxes are paid before that time.

Reserve Fund Policy and Structure (46:19)

Council <u>approved a policy</u> that streamlines the number of city reserve funds, clarifies their purpose and sets suggested amounts for each.

Welcome Service for Newcomers (0:51) [PART 2]

Council <u>debated a motion</u> by Coun. Kathy Barnhart requesting a report examining the possibility of restoring a welcome service for newcomers to the community following the closure of Welcome Wagon. Council directed administration to return with the report by the end of the first quarter in 2021.
