Beaumont Innovation Park (0:50)

City council approved the <u>creation of an innovation business park</u>. The park would establish a location in the city for entrepreneurs and businesses focused on innovation in areas including research and technology.

Recreation Facility Update (1:10:41)

City administration provided an <u>update on the status of Beaumont's recreation facilities</u> in light of the provincial government's ongoing COVID-19 health measures. Council decided to open the Beaumont Sport and Recreation Centre for school programming and wait an additional week to determine whether to close any of the ice sheets at the Ken Nichol Regional Recreation Centre for the season.

Borrowing Bylaw (1:39:54)

Council approved first reading for a <u>bylaw to borrow \$10 million</u> towards the Beaumont Innovation Park, including the purchase of land for the park.
