

2025 Recreation Inclusion Program

The City of Beaumont will subsidize individuals and families who demonstrate an inability to pay for programs and services that would contribute to their personal growth and community involvement.

Subsidy Options

- 1. General application: \$150 per person, per calendar year
- 2. Assured Income for the Severely Handicapped (AISH) application: free access to applicable programs and services

All Applicants

- Open to residents of Beaumont
- Applicant must fill out the following application form
- Funds must be used by December 31 in the calendar year in which they were received
- Applicant must apply annually
- Funds are on a first come first served basis, depending on the allocated yearly budget
- The decision of the City of Beaumont is final

Beaumont's Programs and Services Include

- Registered Programs: swim lessons, fitness classes, art and performing classes
- Beaumont Sport and Recreation Centre: memberships, drop in admissions, punch pass, child mind
