The following form identifies the City of Beaumont's goals and expectations for each stage of engineering drawing submission and resubmission process. Please note that submissions that do not adhere to the expectations noted below may be returned for applicant revision prior to initiating engineering drawing review at any submission or resubmission stage. A formal meeting may also be necessary at any stage to clarify any areas requiring further discussion prior to resubmission.

#### 1st Submission - 4-6 week review period

- •Concept level submission intended to review and accept the engineering design for the project, based on direction set by all relevent engineering studies and reports for the area
- •Identification of any required variances to the General Design Standards shall be made in this submission to ensure the concept can move forward to implementation
- •Intended outcome is formal comments from the City of Beaumont to revise the engineering design concept, as needed, and provide guidance for further refinement

#### 2nd Submission - 4 week review period

- •Submission addresses all 1st Submission comments and is ready for acceptance
- •Includes a cover letter indicating how all 1st Submission comments were addressed
- Drawings are stamped by a P. Eng and submitted in a format permitting review and markup
- Stamped Schedule F shall be submitted along with this submission for consideration
- •Intended outcome is full drawing and Schedule F acceptance, but a 3rd submission may be required to address minor remaining errors/omissions

#### Additional Submissions - 2 - 4 week review period

- Additional Submissions are intended to address minor remaining errors/omissions
- •Submission includes a cover letter indicating how all previous submission comments were addressed
- Drawings are stamped by a P. Eng and submitted in a format permitting review and markup
- •Stamped Schedule F shall be submitted along with this submission for consideration if substantive changes have been made
- •Intended outcome is to resolve remaining minor errors/omissions addressed in previous submissions to allow for full acceptance of the drawing set and Schedule F
